ORIGINAL EQUIPMENT WARRANTY (For U.S. and Canada)

Blodgett warrants to each original Buyer that its electrically-heated or gas-fired units will be free from defects in material and workmanship for the period specified below. Blodgett's obligation under this warranty shall be limited to replacing or repairing, at its option, any part found to be defective within the specified warranty period.

The warranty period begins upon the earlier of the date of installation or 90 days after shipment of the covered product. Any labor expense or part failure incurred after the warranty period will be the responsibility of the end user. Blodgett agrees to pay the authorized Blodgett service agency within the United States or Canada for any labor required to repair or replace, at Blodgett's option, any part which proves to be defective due to defects in material or workmanship during the warranty period. This warranty includes travel time not to exceed two (2) hours and mileage not to exceed one hundred (100) miles, round trip.

This warranty does not cover any defect due to, or resulting from, ordinary wear and tear, handling, abuse, misuse, improper ventilation, or harsh chemical action, nor shall it extend to any unit from which the serial number has been removed or altered, or modifications made by unauthorized service personnel or damage by flood, fire or other acts of God. Adjustments such as calibrations, leveling, tightening of fasteners or plumbing connections normally associated with original installation are the responsibility of the dealer or installer and not that of Blodgett.

Blodgett shall not be liable, directly or indirectly, under any circumstances for consequential or incidental damages, including, but not limited to: (i) any loss of business or profits; and (ii) labor, material or other charges, claims losses or damages incurred or suffered from, in connection with or in consequence of the working upon, alteration, or repair of any such defective products or parts by persons or firms other than Blodgett.

For any oven that connects to a water source, the use of good quality feed water is the responsibility of the Owner-User (see Water Quality Recommendations below). THE USE OF POOR QUALITY FEED WATER WILL VOID EQUIPMENT WARRANTIES. FOR COMBI OVENS, STEAM GENERATOR MAINTENANCE IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE OWNER-USER AND IS NOT COVERED BY THIS WARRANTY. Preventive maintenance records must be available showing descaling performed at recommended intervals.

ORIGINAL EQUIPMENT WARRANTY (For U.S. and Canada)

Blodgett warrants to each original Buyer that its steam units will be free from defects in material and workmanship for the period specified below.

The warranty period begins upon the earlier of the date of installation or 90 days after shipment of the covered product. Blodgett's obligation under this warranty shall be limited to replacing or repairing, at its option, any part found to be defective within the specified warranty period, providing the equipment has been unaltered, and has been PROPERLY INSTALLED, MAINTAINED, AND OPERATED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE BLODGETT STEAM OWNER'S MANUAL.

BLODGETT agrees to pay any FACTORY AUTHORIZED EQUIPMENT SERVICE AGENCY (within the continental United States, and Hawaii) for reasonable labor required to repair or replace, at our option, f.o.b. factory, any part which proves to be defective due to defects in material or workmanship, during the labor warranty period. This warranty includes travel time not to exceed two hours and mileage not to exceed 100 miles roundtrip, BUT DOES NOT INCLUDE MINOR ADJUSTMENTS, MAINTENANCE, CLEANING OR DESCALING.

The standard labor warranty allows factory payment of reasonable labor required to repair or replace such defective parts. Blodgett will not reimburse the expense of labor required for the repair or replacement of parts after the standard warranty period, unless an Extended Labor Warranty has been purchased to cover the equipment for the balance of the warranty period from the date of equipment installation or start-up.

PROPER INSTALLATION IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE DEALER, THE OWNER-USER, OR INSTALLING CONTRACTOR, AND IS NOT COVERED BY THIS WARRANTY. Many local codes exist, and it is the responsibility of the owner and installer to comply with these codes. Blodgett Steam equipment is built to comply with applicable standards for manufacturers, including A.G.A., NSF, ASME, CSA, CGA, and others.

BOILER AND STEAM GENERATOR MAINTENANCE IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE OWNER-USER AND IS NOT COVERED BY THIS WARRANTY. The use of good quality feed water is the responsibility of the Owner-User (see Water Quality Recommendations below). THE USE OF POOR QUALITY FEED WATER WILL VOID EQUIPMENT WARRANTIES. Preventive maintenance records must be available showing descaling performed at recommended intervals.

Blodgett's liability on any claim of any kind, including negligence, with respect to the goods or services covered hereunder, shall in no case exceed the price of the goods or services, or part thereof, which gives rise to the claim. IN NO EVENT SHALL BLODGETT BE LIABLE FOR SPECIAL, INCIDENTAL, OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES, OR ANY DAMAGES IN THE NATURE OF PENALTIES.

LIMITED EXTENDED WARRANTY COVERAGE

The purchase of a Limited Extended Warranty extends the standard warranty coverage from one to two years from the invoice date or date of installation or startup, whichever comes first.

ORIGINAL EQUIPMENT WARRANTY

(For U.S. and Canada)

BLODGETT, HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS THE SELLER, WARRANTS EQUIPMENT MANUFACTURED BY IT TO BE FREE FROM DEFECTS IN MATERIAL AND WORKMANSHIP FOR WHICH IT IS RESPONSIBLE. THE SELLER'S OBLIGATION UNDER THIS WARRANTY SHALL BE LIMITED TO REPLACING OR REPAIRING AT SELLER'S OPTION, WITHOUT CHARGE, ANY PART FOUND TO BE DEFECTIVE AND ANY LABOR AND MATERIAL EXPENSE INCURRED BY SELLER IN REPLACING OR REPAIRING SUCH PART. SUCH WARRANTY SHALL BE LIMITED TO THE ORIGINAL PURCHASER ONLY AND SHALL BE EFFECTIVE FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR FROM DATE OF ORIGINAL INSTALLATION, OR 15 MONTHS FROM DATE OF PURCHASE, WHICHEVER IS EARLIER; PROVIDED THAT TERMS OF PAYMENT HAVE BEEN FULLY MET.

This warranty is valid only if the equipment is installed, started and demonstrated under the supervision of a factory-authorized service agent. Seller shall be responsible only for repairs and/or replacements of defective parts performed by Seller's authorized service agents. Authorized service agencies are located in principal cities throughout the contiguous United States, Alaska and Hawaii.

The foregoing warranty is exclusive and in lieu of all other warranties, expressed or implied. There are no implied warranties of merchantability or of fitness for a particular purpose. The foregoing shall be Seller's sole and exclusive obligation and Buyer's sole and exclusive remedy for any action including breach of contract or negligence. In no event shall Seller be liable for a sum in excess of the purchase price of the item. Seller shall not be liable for any prospective or lost profits of Buyer.

(OPTIONAL) EXTENDED WARRANTY - U.S. and Canada Only

Blodgett will extend the warranty coverage on any Blodgett oven for an additional year when the Extended Warranty option is purchased. The extended warranty is bound by all the terms and conditions described above. The extended warranty may be purchased at the point of sale, but may also be purchased up to 90 days after the original installation, or 120 days from the date of shipment from the factory, whichever is earlier.
